Ron Hull Demolition was appointed as the Principal Contractor for the dismantling project at the live E.ON (UK) Ltd site at Ratcliffe Power Station. The work involved close liaison with E.ON and resident contractors to ensure the power station remained in production with minimal disruption.

The project involved large crane operations 500t and above, with limited space available and very close proximity to active rail and road operations, requiring very detailed schedule of working procedures.

In addition, intensive and continuous small crane operations were necessary.

Close restrictions working in and around active intensive continuous processes critical to clients needs, and compliance with elaborate site access and operating procedures were imposed by the client.
