

CASE STUDY WELBECK COLLIERY

The demolition works were carried out over a 7 month period and included the demolition of various steel framed and brick constructed buildings and the eventual crushing of brick arisings using Ron Hull Demolition Ltd's own fully licensed mobile crushing plant.

Various asbestos containing materials were identified on site as per the survey provided and these were removed by an approved licensed sub-contractor who was fully monitored during the course of the works.

Controlled explosive demolition was carried out on the Head Gear Building, Coal Prep Plant and the Rapid Loading Bunkers. Various road closure and third party measures were implemented to ensure that this operation was achieved in a smooth and efficient manner as per regulatory requirements and the safe systems of work developed.
